



## **South Channel Garden Club Scholarship**

Following a collaboration between The South Channel Garden Club and Five Bob Farm at Birchs Bay, the South Channel Garden Club is launching 2 scholarships to pave the way for green-fingered students to study for a career in fields related to horticulture or plant science.

### **What does the Scholarship provide?**

Up to \$3,000 a year, for a full-time, three-year course (Maximum of \$9,000) A pro rata equivalent applies for part time studies. Industry mentoring will also be a key part of the programme.

### **Who should apply**

The scheme will be open to South Channel residents or those with links to the area and is open to year 12 school leavers, existing or potential University of Tasmania students and TAFE students, in horticulture, plant science or a related field. It may also embrace those who are already in the workforce and considering a career change.
