The Tasmania Police Charity Trust Scholarship Fund offers up to three scholarships for eligible Tasmanians in each major region of the state – south, north and north-west.

This is part of the Trust's commitment to supporting Tasmanians who may be facing financial barriers in their ability to undertake and complete training at TasTAFE.

Special consideration will be given to applicants who may be prevented from reaching their educational potential because of family or other life circumstances, for example lived experience of family violence"

The scholarships are available to TasTAFE students who have enrolled and start a full qualification in Semester 1, 2025 (including Fee-Free TAFE qualifications).

The scholarship is worth \$2,000. The scholarships will directly contribute to a student's ability to undertake and complete a full qualification.

About Tasmania Police Charity Trust

The Tasmania Police Charity Trust has a proud history of helping the most vulnerable and at-risk members of our community.

It was established in 2006 to provide the opportunity for Tasmania Police and State Service employees to raise funds to support children and young people in need. The Trust is administered through the Department of Police, Fire and Emergency Management (DPFEM), so 100% of funds raised go to those who need it.

The Charity Trust is run by a Board and members volunteer their time to identify fundraising opportunities and recipients for donations. Fund raisers include the Charity Trust Bike Ride, Golf Day and quiz nights. And each fortnight DPFEM staff donate to the Trust through salary deductions.

1. Structure

- The value is \$2,000 per scholarship to directly contribute to costs associated with
 accessing and participating in training at TasTAFE. This may include tuition and
 upfront course fees, transport costs, textbooks, internet access, along with anything
 else that will have a demonstrated impact on the ability to undertake and engage
 with study at TasTAFE.
- It is available to eligible students who have enrolled in a full qualification at TasTAFE in Semester 1, 2025.
- The scholarship will be paid in full upon nomination of eligible and suitable applicants selected by a panel comprising TasTAFE staff and a representative of the Tasmania Police Charity Trust.
- Scholarships are awarded to applicants who, at the discretion of the selection panel, have fully met the scholarship criteria.

2. Eligibility

- Applicants must be Australian citizens or have permanent Australian resident status.
- Applicants must be enrolled in a TasTAFE qualification starting in Semester 1, 2025.
- Applicants must be committed to complete the nominated qualification at TasTAFE in an appropriate timeframe.
- Applicants must complete and submit the application form provided by TasTAFE.

- Applicants must attest that they are not in receipt of any other scholarship valued in excess of \$500 in total at the time of application.
- Applicants must provide evidence of:
 - (i) a commitment to study; and
 - a (ii) commitment to using the scholarship to directly assist with accessing and participating in training at TasTAFE.

Administration

- Shortlisting of eligible recipients will be conducted by a selection panel.
- The panel will assess shortlisted applicants and then forward recommendations to the Tasmanian Police Charity Board, who will approve recipients to receive scholarships. The Charity Board's decision is final.
- TasTAFE will notify all applicants in writing of the outcome of their application.
- All information supplied to panel members, along with relevant TasTAFE and DPFEM staff, is treated as confidential.
